To request the RI Board to consider recommending that all club meetings begin with The Four-Way Test

1 WHEREAS, The Four-Way Test is an expression of service as Rotary’s guiding  
2 principle through four concrete examples, and

4 WHEREAS, The Four-Way Test is so important that it is included in the Standard  
5 Rotary Club Constitution as one of the guidelines for club membership, and

7 WHEREAS, many clubs do not recite The Four-Way Test during their meetings,

10 WHEREAS, as a result, there are clubs where some members do not know The  
11 Four-Way Test

13 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary  
14 International consider recommending that all club meetings begin with the  
15 recital of The Four-Way Test, which expresses Rotary’s guiding principles.
