

RESOLUTION 17R-25

To request the Trustees to consider securing a status report before sending club donations

1 WHEREAS, it is recognized that various international clubs and other entities
2 directly channel their donations to local clubs, and

4 WHEREAS, some of these clubs may not be members in good standing, and

6 WHEREAS, it is imperative that donations and any grants afforded by
7 international donors and partner clubs be safeguarded from being utilized for,
8 and applied to, activities and undertakings contrary to the objects and thrusts of
9 RI

11 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
12 International consider requesting the Trustees of The Rotary Foundation to
13 consider requiring that international donors and partner clubs join together and
14 secure a status report from the district concerned prior to giving or sending
15 donations directly to local clubs.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT

16 The aim of this resolution is to monitor donations that are channeled directly to
17 local clubs and to ensure that these donations are devoted to activities and
18 purposes within the aims and thrusts of RI.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

19 If implemented, this resolution would have a financial impact on RI due to
20 increased monitoring and reporting requirements. Currently, Rotary does not
21 have visibility into club-to-club donations.
