

RESOLUTION 17R-38

To request the RI Board to consider training Council representatives on how to use voting equipment

Proposer(s): Rotary Club of Kushiro, District 2500, Japan

Endorsed by: District 2500 through a ballot-by-mail, 23 June 2017

1 WHEREAS, in each Council on Legislation, votes are cast electronically, and
2
3 WHEREAS, on the first day of the 2016 Council, nearly one hundred votes were
4 not included in the vote count because representatives were unfamiliar with their
5 voting equipment, and

7 WHEREAS, such a system can lead to imprecise voting

9 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
10 International consider holding a session on the proper handling of voting
11 equipment, to be held during the rehearsal on the day before the 2019 Council on
12 Legislation, and consider changing the Council's voting equipment to one that
13 enables easier casting of votes.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT

14 The purpose of this proposal is as stated in the main body of the text. Its effect
15 would be to produce more precise voting results, thus promoting confidence in
16 the Council on Legislation among Rotarians around the world.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

17 If implemented, this resolution would have no substantial financial impact on RI.
18 Prior to the start of each Council on Legislation, a training session is held for the
19 representatives to learn how to use the voting equipment. Additionally, the
20 supplier of voting equipment is evaluated triennially.
